- This ticket entitles the holder to round trip travel to Mount Pilatus by cogwheel railway from Alpnachstad or by cable car from Kriens.
- Pilatus offers a unique excursion with the world's steepest cogwheel railway, spectacular cable car, and modern panorama gondolas. The highlight of the tour is the magnificent view from 7,000 feet above sea level.
- The cogwheel is the steepest of its kind in the world! It starts at the base of Mount Pilatus in Alpnachstad and runs over uniquely constructed tracks to the summit of the mountain. This train operates from May to November. (depending on snow conditions)
- Travelers can enjoy Swiss culinary delights in various restaurants at the mountaintop with an impressive panoramic view.
- As clients arrive at the Pilatus Summit, they will behold the magnificent view of 73 Alpine peaks and 5 different lakes and the Midlands. They may also visit the hotels and restaurants with breathtaking panoramic terraces.

How to reach Kriens and Alphachstad


Kriens

Kriens can be reached from Lucerne by bus. From there a panoramic gondola will be boarded and then a cable car to the top of Mount Pilatus (operates year round).

Alpnachstad

Alpnachstad can be reached from Lucerne or Interlaken by train (Golden Pass Line) and from Lucerne also by boat or train, from where the cogwheel railway starts for the summit of Mount Pilatus.

 Note: the Swiss Pass covers both the boat and train ride from Lucerne to Alphachstad and the bus ride from Lucerne to Kriens.



Conditions

- Must be purchased in conjunction with a Swiss Pass, Swiss Flexipass, Swiss Saverpass or Swiss Saver Flexipass.
- There is no "Saver discount". Each adult must buy a full fare ticket.
- Pilatus Euronet vouchers must be exchanged at the village station in Alphachstad or Kriens.

Refund policy

- Vouchers must be presented, completely unused, to the issuing office for a refund. Not refundable if the Swiss Pass, Swiss Flexipass, Swiss Saverpass or Swiss Saver Flexipass portion has been used.
- A 15% cancellation penalty will apply to unused vouchers returned within one year of issue date
