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## ENGELBERG

THE VILLAGE OF ENGELBERG IS  
NESTLED BETWEEN THE BEAUTIFUL  
LOWER ALPS IN A VALLEY,

Engelberg was hit hard by summer  
RAINS AND FLOODING - SO MUCH SO THAT  
THE TOWN WAS ISOLATED FOR THREE WEEKS  
IN AUGUST - AIRLIFTS OF FOOD & SUPPLIES  
WERE TO BE ENACTED SINCE THE RAIL AND  
ROAD LINES WERE LOGGED OUT.

BREAKFAST AT THE LANDGUT WAS VERY  
GOOD - AND AS USUAL SWISS COFFEE -  
INCLUDES WITH THIS ROOM.

AFTER BREAKFAST WE TURNED AROUND  
TO THE CABLE CAR TO MT. TITUS.  
THE FIRST CABLE IS TO ABOUT 800 METERS  
AND A SLEET RUN.

THE SECOND CABLE CAR (YOU CAN STAY  
ON THE SAME CAR) GOES ACROSS A  
GREEN PASTURING VALLEY COMPLETE WITH  
MILK COWS AND BELLS HANGING, THE  
THIRD CABLE IS A LONG CABLE CAR  
WHICH TAKES YOU TO THE FINAL  
ASCENT TO TITUS.

THE FINE CLOUDS ARE WITH

SIGNATURES FOR THIS ROTATE  
CLOUDS WHICH LASTS ABOUT 15 MINUTES

THE LIFT IS DYNAMIC FROM ROCK  
TO TUNNEL AND FINALLY TO GLACIER  
FROM

THE CLOUDS POSITION SITS IN THE  
MOUNTAINS WHILE THE ENTIRE SPHERE  
MOVES IN A 360 DEGREES SWELL  
PAN - WITH A GREAT VIEW.

THIS SWELL ARE CONSIDERED ASSET  
ENGINEERING LEADS TO GET TO  
THE TOP OF VERTICAL ASCENTS  
AND GRAND VIEWS!


ONCE AT THE TOP THERE IS  
A COMPLEX OF BARS, RESTAURANTS  
AND VIEWING AREAS.

WE STARTED AT A TOUR OF  
THE INSIDE OF THE GLACIER -  
145 FT. BELOW THE SNOW AND  
ICE. THERE ARE TUNNELS CARVED  
OUT WITH A LIGHT/SOUND SHOW  
WHICH IS ACCOMPLISHED AS YOU  
WALK THROUGH.

ON THE TOP OF THE COMPLEX  
THERE IS A WONDERFUL VIEWS  
OUT FRONT, WITH SNACK STANDS,  
PICNIC TABLES, SUNBATHING CHAIRS,  
AND ACCESS TO THE SUMMIT OF MT.  
PILATUS.

THE VIEW TO THE NORTH IS OF  
ENGLISCHORN - IN SWISS IN THE UNTUCKY.

TO THE SOUTH IS A RANGE OF VISTAS  
MOUNTAINS AND GLACIERS - TO  
A DISTANT VIEW OF THE WEST OF  
THE BERNER OBERLAND - AND  
OF JUNGFRUJÖCH.



CUM WITH SOME CLOUDS RAINING  
FORMING - BUT THE FIELD IS  
SOON CLOUDLESS.

THE WIND WAS LOW, AND THE  
TEMPERATURE WAS AROUND  $6^{\circ}\text{C}$  OR  
 $32^{\circ}\text{f}$  - LOWER IN THE SUN IT WAS  
COMFORTABLE IN SHORTS + A T-SHIRT  
WITH FLEECE NECK.

THE BEAUTIFUL ROARING GLACIERS  
LIES THROUGHOUT THE ALPINE RANGES,  
AND EVERYDAY SUPPLY ENOUGH  
WATER FOR 60% OF SWITZERLAND  
POWER, AND UP TO 75% OF THE  
WATER WHICH MAKES UP THE  
RHINE RIVER.

After a walk in the snow  
and a snack, we took the  
cable car down to the MTA  
stop where a local lake is  
nestled on a plateau.

A short ride to a hutte  
on the other side of the  
Grauen Gletscher is now a  
clean - lift, which provides  
a great vista in the summer  
season. On average CHF 10  
you can go up and down this  
lift - maximum 2-3 person.

We see a mountain biker  
go up carrying his bike.

There are also a number  
of huts and refuges in the  
area for various levels of  
Alpine terrain.

Later in MTA that the  
lifts stop around 4:45 in  
summer lifts and 5:45 P.M. for  
the main lift.

You can also rent a  
mountain bike (downhill) or lift  
CHF 8 for the last segment  
down.

level Wellness area.

Basically the Wellness area  
is a pool, spa, sauna, steam




