Upon our arrival at San Juan, United States Customs and Immigration will carry out an inspection of ALL guests.

All guests are required to attend this mandatory inspection and each individual must attend in person. This Inspection will take place in the Main Salon situated on deck 3 and is expected to commence at 07.00 a.m. on Sunday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, once the Officials have boarded. The officials require all guests to attend this inspection properly dressed and will not see those guests for example in bathrobes.

Regrettably the local authorities will not clear the ship until the inspection is completed.

We kindly ask all guests to complete and sign a United States Customs form, which should be presented to the boarding Customs officers. Only one Customs Declaration is required per family or household (same last name or address).

Please bring the declaration when attending the inspection.

Your passport will be returned to you at the inspection.
