

A DESCRIPTION OF OUR SHIPBOARD DRESS CODES

Shipboard attire ranges from casual to informal. Casual wear is appropriate for daytime on board the ship or ashore, and consists of resort-style outfits. Bermuda type shorts are suitable for breakfast and lunch in the Compass Rose Restaurant and La Veranda Restaurant. Shorts are not appropriate after 6:00 p.m. in any of the public rooms or lounges. We kindly ask you not to wear bathing suits in the Restaurants and Lounges at any time. Evening attire can be either country club casual or informal. The suggested evening dress code is listed in your Passages daily newsletter and applies throughout the evening. Please note that La Veranda restaurant features casual attire for dinner, while the Signatures restaurant requires at least informal attire. COUNTRY CLUB CASUAL: Smart casual attire, open neck shirts and slacks for gentlemen. Slacks, skirts and blouses for ladies.

INFORMAL: Jackets are required for gentlemen; ties are optional.

Dresses, matching separates or pant suits are appropriate for ladies.

FORMAL: Tuxedo (alternatively a dark business suit) for gentlemen; evening gown, cocktail dresses or appropriate formal evening attire for ladies.

However, steam irons and ironing boards are provided in the self-service launderettes located on Decks 6,7,8, 9 and 10 mid-ship.

KNUT HANSSEN

MASTER OF **SEVEN SEAS VOYAGER**

As master of the vessel, Captain Knut Hanssen is ultimately responsible for the entire vessel operation on behalf of the Owners, Operators and Marine Authorities.

Captain Hanssen claims he went to sea in 1977 "by pure accident". After finishing high school, he wanted to have a look at the world, and a way to do that was to sign on as an apprentice on one of the cargo ships in North Sea trade.

He served his time in the Royal Norwegian Navy from 1979 until 1980, before finding his way back on bulk carriers and RoRo (Roll-On, Roll-Off) container ships in world-wide trade. In 1987, after rising through the ranks and finishing his final year at the Maritime Academy, he received his first command as Master of a general cargo ship in North Sea trade.

The weather in the North Sea is infamous, and the winter of 1989 to 1990 was a particularly bad one. "After what felt like a continuous 6-week storm, I said to myself there has to be an easier way of making a living, so when I was offered to join *Song of Flower* in Japan as Safety/Chief Officer in April 1990, I didn't think twice".

By 1992 he was promoted to Staff Captain on Song of Flower. In 1997 he left RSSC for a Master's position on high speed passenger ferries in the North Sea, running between Norway and Denmark, which he operated for two years full time and still does periodically during his 'vacations'.

By late 1998, he rejoined Radisson Seven Seas Cruises and Song of Flower as her Master, a position he held until he was asked to transfer to Radisson Diamond in early 2000. Then, in 2003, he went on to be appointed Master of the newly launched Seven Seas Voyager. Knut, like all Captains, has a duty

rotation of three months onboard and three months on leave. When he's not on board he spends his time at his home in Aalesund,

Norway, where you may very well find him mountain hiking in the summer, and skiing in the winter. And, although he enjoys being home, Knut still likes to travel during his three months leave. He just doesn't go cruising, in case you were wondering...

Monte Carlo

MONACO

All of Monaco's international visitors seem to agree that the tiny nation is utterly seductive. A "chic" dream of perfection, the fairytale principality even looks the part. The Monegasque citizens adore the Royal Family and members are often in residence.

There is great confusion about the small country, so just to clarify the official name of the sovereign state is The Principality of Monaco. The principality, about the size of London's Hyde Park, consists of five departments. Monte Carlo, the most famous of them, was established and named by Prince Charles III in 1866. Waging that the pretty cliff top village would save his principality,

he established a casino on the crag. News of the gaming house spread quickly and soon, people came to think of the country as Monte-Carlo, rather than Monacothe two names have (erroneously) been used interchangeably.

Monaco-Ville, the original fortified city, is home to the Royal Family. In addition to the palace, the famous Oceanographic Museum and the Cathedral can be found in the district. Beyond and below Monaco-Ville, Fontvieille is home to the *zoo* and stadium. The department is especially remarkable since the entire lower section containing the stadium, Parc de Fontvieille and marina, was created by filling in more than 120 feet of sea with rock and earth. The reclaimed land represents 20% of Monaco's

total landmass. Fontvieille also has its own tiny marina, though the yachts that bob alongside its docks are anything but tiny.

Monaco's story begins in the shadows of time. The earliest visitors were probably Ligurians, but there was no attraction for tribes seeking arable land and shelter. The "land" was an unwelcoming rock, but evidence suggests the cliffs were possibly used for human sacrifice. The period leading up to the Grimaldi dynasty was not uneventful, but it was the House of Grimaldi that turned the single square mile into some of the world's most prized real estate. Monaco's Palace of the Prince was the target of many attacks and much effort went into fortifying the structure. The Grimaldi's had to act with great diplomatic agility in order to maintain the tiny principality.

Having developed a fascination for romance languages also, Elsa went on to study "Spanish Translation and Cultural Anthropology" at university to further develop her understanding of the ancient



AJACCIO BIRTHPLACE OF NAPOLEON


jaccio, Corsica is a lovely pastel-coloured walking town and the birthplace of Napoleon Bonaparte. But don't let on that you know that after Napoleon became emperor, he never once returned. A path leads you to the end of the point from where you can admire the lies Sanguinaires and access the beaches of the large and small Capo di Feno. The turquoise waters and wild landscape make this place a favourite with surfers and it is sure to transport you miles away from the hustle and bustle of city life. To reach the southern coastline and the seaside resort of Porticcio, you can choose between the coastal road or a sea shuttle. With its three valleys, three rivers, overlooked by two Genoese watchtowers, the whole of the southern coast is a fantastic place to visit and an ideal spot for getting away from it





Ajaccio, Corsica is a lovely pastel-coloured walking town and the birthplace of Napoleon Bonaparte — pictured here.

While Corsica was living drama after another, falling under the blows of the invaders and rising to tear itself, Ajaccio led an almost quiet life. Until its conquest by Sampiero Corso in 1553, it was reserved to the Genoese. Finally in 1592, Corsican set there. Ajaccio considerably grew in the 18th century and inherited the title of capital of Corsica. Then the city grew. Men shaped it according to his needs and not only to his desires anymore.







SORRENTO

COAST OF AMALFI

■ taly's Campania region is just south of Lazio, the Roman province and marks the beginning of the country's rich south. The coastline ranks with the world's most spectacular and the people seem to have a particularly close connection to their land. Traditional fishing villages still thrive, seemingly untouched by time, and even the bustling capital of Naples maintains the charming atmosphere of a small town. Romans have always viewed the region with tacit admiration - in fact, the name of the district is a shortened form, of the affectionate Latin designation campania felix ("land of happiness"). Perhaps the happiest part of the happy province is the Sorrento Peninsula Unquestionably one of the most magnificent places on earth, it's relaxed lifestyle defies comparison. Even upon arrival at the tender landing, visitors often notice how unhurried the pace of life is on the peninsula. The warm moist Mediterranean air and seductive characteristic charm completes the alluring scene.

The Amalfi Coast, Pompeii, Herculaneum, the legendary Isle of Capri are all at your fingertips - near, yet far enough from the grasp of bustling Naples to make the huge City seem only as a foreign place on a distant horizon.

Sorrento's main district is perched above the marina on a cliff. Buses and taxis depart from its central Piazza Tasso to take eager visitors to the fabled Amalfi Coast or to drive back to the mainland where excavations have revealed the remains of two ancient cities buried under Pompeii. Sorrento is a quiet place. It's beaches are small and the atmosphere is utterly charming. Be sure to venture at least a little way out of the captivating town, however. The narrow roads that wind along both sides of the slender peninsula offer breathtaking views - especially the famed southern route known as the Amalfi Drive. Daring Italian visitors might be seen on rented Vespas along the coast, but scooters and motorcycles are not recommended for novice visitors.

If you have never seen the celebrated Isle of Capri, you may want to cross over on a local boat for a visit. With a permanent population of only 8,000 people, it is located at the southern end of the Bay of Naples not far from Sorrento. The island, just four miles long and two miles wide, is in fact a peninsular extension. It was probably connected to Sorrento at one time, but centuries of seismic activity and rising sea levels have changed things. A five-minute walk from the tender landing at Sorrento brings you to the ferry dock where hydrofoils jet periodically to Capri. Capri visitors should bear in mind that hydrofoils are generally reliable, but there have been delays in the past caused by engine breakdowns. If something goes awry, operators only shrug their shoulders and set to repairing the trouble, perhaps after first taking a cappuccino or granite break. In southern Italy, things happen that way. Life marches along at it's own pace, with or without human assistance.





Treasures of CAMPANIA

s you journey down the fabled Amalfi Coast, the route takes you past rocky cliffs plunging into the sea and small boats lying in sandy coves like brightly colored fish. Erosion has contorted the rocks into shapes resembling figures from mythology and hollowed out fairy grottoes where the air is turquoise and the water an icy blue. White villages dripping with flowers nestle in coves or climb like vines up the steep, terraced hills. Lemon trees abound, loaded with blossom or fruit-and netting in winter to protect the fruit. The inhabitants jest that they look after their lemons better than their children. The road must have a thousand turns, each with a different view. on its dizzying 69-km (43-mi) journey from Sorrento to Salerno. Venture north, and you can fall under the spell of Pompeii's silent streets, frozen in time under the dust of 25 centuries.

A busy commercial center with a population of 10,000 to 20,000, ancient Pompeii covered about 160 acres on

the seaward end of the fertile Sarno Plain. On a quiet backstreet, all you need is a little imagination to sense the shadows palpably filling the dark corners, to hear the ancient pipe's falsetto and the tinny clash of cymbals, to envision a rain of rose petals gently covering a Roman senator's dinner guests.

As you enter the ruins at Porta Marina, make your way to the Foro (Forum), which served as Pompeii's cultural, political, and religious center. Fronted by an elegant three-column portico on the eastern side of the forum is the Macellum, the covered meat and fish market dating to Augustan times. Worshippers once crowded the Tempio di Giove (Temple of Jupiter), at the northern end of the Forum. On the southwestern corner is the Basilica, the city's law court and the economic center; the Roman basilica design was the model for early Christian churches. The Anfiteatro (Amphitheater) was the ultimate in

entertainment for local Pompeians and offered a gamut of experiences.

John Steinbeck's observation about Positano, a village of white Moorishstyle houses clinging to slopes around a small sheltered bay, still applies: "Positano bites deep. It is a dream place that isn't quite real when you are there and becomes beckoningly real after you have gone." Be prepared to negotiate the daunting scalinatelle (little stairways), or ride the municipal bus, which makes a loop through the town every half hour.

Capri is a Moorish opera set of shiny white houses, tiny squares, and narrow medieval alleyways hung with flowers. The island's rare and delicious white wine is sensuous and intoxicating.

On arrival at the port, pick up a map at the tourist office and take the cog railway to Capri Town, perched some 450 feet above the harbor. Windowshop in expensive boutiques along Via Vittorio Emanuele, which leads south toward the many-domed Certosa di San Giacomo.

When the Grotta Azzurra was discovered in 1826 by the Polish poet August Kopisch and Swiss artist Ernest Fries, Capri become a tourist haven. The water's extraordinary sapphire color is caused by a hidden opening in the rock that refracts the light. Marina Grande.

Amalfi's main historical sight is its Duomo (also known as Cattedrale di Sant'Andrea), which shows an interesting mix of Moorish and early Gothic influences. You're channeled first into the adjoining Chiostro del Paradiso (Paradise Cloister), one of the architectural treasures of southern Italy.

The Valle dei Mulini (Valley of the Mills), uphill from town, was for centuries Amalfi's center for papermaking. Though most of the mills have closed, the paper samples, tools of the trade, old machinery, and audiovisual presentation at the Museo della Carta (Museum of Paper, \$) are all enlightening.







DISEMBARKATION PROCEDURES

Disembarkation is anticipated to commence at approximately 8:30 a.m. and last until 10:00 a.m. These times are dependent upon the clearance of the ship by local officials; also, disembarkation cannot begin until all luggage has been off-loaded. For your own safety and to comply with strict security regulations, please do not congregate near the gangway area. Kindly wait in any of the ship's lounges for announcements. Announcements will be made calling for guests to disembark the ship by luggage tag colour. When your luggage tag color has been called, please proceed ashore where the Travel Concierge Staff and shore-side porters will assist you with your luggage and transportation. Due to transportation timings please only proceed ashore when your colour is called. If you come ashore sooner your transportation will not be available.

SUITES

Guests are kindly requested to vacate their suites by 8:30 a.m. on the day of disembarkation. Please remember to double check your drawers, closets and safe for any items you may have overlooked. Before leaving your suite, please remember to empty your safe of all valuables and leave the safe door open.

LUGGAGE HANDLING

In order to assist us with luggage handling, we ask that you remove all old ship/airline/hotel luggage tags from the luggage you would like us to take off the ship, as these may confuse the porters. Please fill out and attach the new color-coded tags enclosed. Please print your name, suite number and destination (i.e. the name of your hotel or "home").

Pack any valuables or necessities for the next morning (passports, tickets, shoes, clothing for the day, cosmetics, medication, etc.) in your hand luggage and not in the luggage placed outside your suite.
