THE UNDERWATER SNORKEL TRAILS OF TRUNK BAY

If you are new to snorkeling, your guide is happy to provide instruction. If you are an "old hand," you'll find an abundance and variety of sea creatures and underwater terrains to explore. Simply put, it doesn't get any more beautiful than this! Note: Be sure to wear sunscreen to protect you from the sun. A T-shirt is recommended for snorkeling. Trunk Bay is subject to sea swells and snorkeling will be canceled should weather conditions not permit a safe operation...

ST. JOHN ECO-HIKE OF LIND POINT TRAIL

Your adventure today is a walk back in time to a bygone era of unspoiled beauty. Fabulous flora and fauna surround you on the one+ Departs: 09:00 mile hike through the lush national forest of St. John and along the Caneel Bay trail built by the slaves who once worked this sugar plantation. From your guide, hear how the Tianos Amerindians took part in the historic "Columbian Exchange." Did you know that the red hibiscus flower steeped in hot water will cure the common cold? Learn of the medicinal values of different plants and trees. From Lind Point, enjoy the view of St. Thomas and the British Virgin Islands as your guide recounts the history of St. John - tales of Bluebeard, Sir Francis Drake and the infamous pirate days of looting and murder. Descend to beautiful Honeymoon Beach where you can relax and enjoy a refreshing dip or snorkel in the pristine turquoise waters. Then it's on to a short botanical walk to the ruins of Caneel Bay Plantation before returning to SeaDream with an intimate overview of one of the most interesting and beautiful Nature

ST. JOHN BY 4WD Adventure: STJ-6

St. John's roads are in excellent condition and its hilly terrain is visually entertaining to explore, as each peak offers a beautiful view. **Departs: 09:00** Beaches abound as well, and this is the fun way of acquainting yourself with the coves, harbors, cays and peaks that make up this

National Park. The vehicles are four-wheel drive with manual transmissions. We supply a map, fuel and insurance and you're off for the day. With only 400 residents, what you won't find is pollution or a traffic jam, so go for it! Note: The vehicle holds up to four people. There is a limited supply on the island, please book onboard early to avoid disappointment. Limited automatic

The tour price is per car and includes full risk insurance with \$500 deductible. The deductible is fully or partially charged to the driver's credit card in case the car is returned damaged. Guests will be asked to sign a contract and a control sheet prior to departing on the trip. Cars must be returned to their pick up point. Maximum speed limit on the island is 50-kmh/31 mph.

NATIONAL PARK KAYAK ADVENTURE

The kayaks are for two persons and all you need is your bathing suit and a pair of reef walkers or other shoes that can get wet. Note: Remember to bring sun protection and a towel.

RACING CATAMARAN SAILING

This trip appeals to those with a spirit of adventure and a love of sailing. Designed as a high performance race cat, every attempt to save weight onboard has been made. As a result, there are not as many creature comforts as a typical catamaran. There is no Jimmy Buffett, rum punch, or freshly baked bread. The hum of the rudders slicing the water at 20+knots is more like it. As a member of the race crew, you will get a chance to trim the sails, take the tiller, and fly a hull. We provide racing shoes, top of the line paddling life vests, drinks, and snacks. There is a swim ladder and plenty of room to lounge on the wide trampoline. There is also a port-a-potty down below. Soft drinks, water, beer and light snacks including granola bars, cookies and fresh fruit are included. Participation on this adventure is strictly limited to no more than six participants; so book early. Or why not reserve the entire Catamaran for your private party? Dress as you would for a trip to the beach or a light hike; swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and sunscreen are recommended.

SEADREAM II

Dear SEADREAM Guest,

It is our sincere pleasure to welcome you aboard SEADREAM II.

As you may be aware this past year there has been a substantial increase in outbreaks of Norovirus in several major US cities and across the United Kingdom and elsewhere. The Norovirus (or Norwalk virus flu) is a very common, highly contagious gastrointestinal ailment easily transmitted via "contaminated hands". It's as simple as coming in contact with a contaminated surface. You can not see the virus and in fact the contaminated surface may look clean. One of the unique characteristics of this virus is that in any environment with people -- airports, planes, buses, restaurants, stores, ships or elsewhere the potential exists to unexpectedly touch a contaminated surface.

Although the Norovirus can't be cured, it can be prevented. The most important weapon against the Norovirus is **"hand hygiene"** such as vigorous washing with soap and warm water or using an alcohol hand sanitizers. Good hygiene practice is our first and last line of defense, and limiting outbreaks depends largely on the ability of those infected to remain isolated for the duration of the infectious period. We therefore ask you to assist us with the following steps to help protect against a Norovirus outbreak:

- Take extra precautions in continually cleansing your hands many times a day and always prior to any food or drink consumption.
- Each time you re-embark during the voyage from an excursion, sightseeing, or a meal ashore please wash your hands or utilize the chlorinated towels or antibacterial hand sanitizer provided by our staff at the gangway.
- The Center for Disease Control encourages the use of antibacterial sanitizers following hand washing which will also be placed around the yacht for your use and safety.
- If you feel like you are experiencing symptoms of Norovirus, immediately contact the ship's doctor.

Thanks for helping us protect you and all guests and crew.
