

Dear Princess Guest,

I hope you are enjoying your voyage on board Star Princess.

With our call to Skagway, Alaska on 4 June 2026, I wanted to bring some details about our visit to your attention. As you may be aware, in 2022 the port area in Skagway was affected by nearby rockslides. Guests are currently not permitted to walk in the area where construction on mitigation measures is underway.

As a result, in Skagway the port will provide shuttle buses to transport guests to and from the ship. Guests will not be able to access the ship via foot. There will be no change to our call times in Skagway, and Princess shore excursions will proceed as scheduled, though you may want to allow yourself a little extra time to travel ashore. If possible, **we recommend you avoid peak times**, anticipated to be between **7:30am - 10:00am** and during the arrival times of White Pass Scenic Railway tours: **11:30am - 12:30pm** and **3:30pm - 4:30pm**.

We regret any inconvenience this may cause and appreciate your understanding. On behalf of all of us on board Star Princess, we look forward to exploring Alaska with you.
